- Operate the point of sale system to sell admissions, memberships, and gift shop items.
- Perform daily remittances and deposits.
- Record the number of visitors and program attendance.
- Record where visitors are from and how they heard about the Owl Center
- Record memberships in the database and e-newsletter list.
- Fill out and mail membership materials.
- Fill and ship online gift shop orders.
- Receive order shipments, update inventory, label and stock merchandise.
- Price merchandise with approval of the Executive Director.
- Maintain clean and attractive merchandise displays.
- Staff the Owl Center gift shop during open hours.
- Answer the phone and direct calls as appropriate.
- Answer basic questions about the Owl Center and our owls.
- Suggest additional activities for visitors (restaurants, playgrounds, other attractions).
- Maintain a clean building, including sweeping, mopping, cleaning the restroom, windows, and cleaning up owl pellets and droppings as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Strong knowledge of attractions and roads in Houston and surrounding communities

- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
