## Catnip ice cream cones!



## A quick and easy pattern to make ice cream cones for your cats. Pattern by porchparty.

## You will need:

- 3.75 mm yarn hook (or smaller size)
- Yarn needle
- Worsted weight yarn in beige or brown
- Worsted weight yarn in any other color
- Yarn scraps for sprinkles
- Catnip
- Polyfil

We will be starting from the top of the ice cream and moving onto the cone, stuffing with catnip and polyfil as we go.

Start with your ice cream color:

1. 6 sc in magic loop
2. 2 sc in each sc
3. (1 sc, in) $x 6$
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{in}) \times 6$
5. Repeat
6. Repeat
7. Repeat
8. Repeat
9. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 6$
10. FLO ( 3 hdc, 4 hdc) $\times 9$

Switch to cone color here

1. In BLO of round $9(7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$

Tie the tails from the cone color and ice cream color together here.
2. Repeat
3. $(6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$
4. Repeat
5. $(5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$

Stuff the cone with catnip here. It might get messy!
6. Repeat
7. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$
8. Repeat
9. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$
10. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2$

Stuff the remainder with polyfil. I like to make mine firm.
Tie off and sew together to finish up.
Add sprinkles and give to cat.
